FROM OUR EDITOR

Dear Stakeholders

As of February, we met with our students and the Spring term started quickly with student-centred trainings and productive activities. We are very happy with the news we receive from you and include in our e-bulletin. In this article, I would like to continue the series of informative articles about YÖKAK Standards that I started last month and I will talk about Mission and Strategic Objectives, which is the second title under the main title of Leadership, Governance and Quality.

Mission shows the reason for an organization's existence, and vision shows where it wants to be in the future. Institutions set strategic goals and objectives to realise their mission and vision, monitor these goals with performance indicators and share the results with the public. According to standard requirements;

Mission, Vision and Policies are announced to all stakeholders and it is ensured that everyone knows the direction we look in common. We have devoted one page of our bulletin to the mission and vision as a reminder. Likewise, there are policies on education and training (including distance education), research and development, social contribution, governance system and internationalisation. All this information is available on our university's website, the quality website (www.kalite.altinbas.edu.tr) and through the alyans system. These elements shape the corporate culture and provide guidance for a sustainable future. They are reviewed and evaluated at certain intervals. The Quality Assurance and Quality Improvement Procedure defines quality assurance and manages our processes in line with the guidelines. All these processes are shaped by the opinions and suggestions of our stakeholders. Strategic Aims and Objectives: Our Strategic Plan and Quality Assurance Directive is defined and the strategic plan of our institution has been prepared by taking the opinions of our internal and external stakeholders in line with this procedure, and performance indicators for the targets are actively monitored and reported to you, our stakeholders. Our new Strategic Plan was prepared with the participation of all our stakeholders with the Strategy Planning Board and Strategy Development Team. Our new period strategic plan goals were created in integration with YÖKAK Standards and our processes followed by YÖKAK, and the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals were also taken into consideration. Our performance indicators are monitored during the target achievement phase and analysed at specified periods. Stakeholder opinions are received every month and evaluated in the commission and improvement is planned when necessary.

Performance Management: Performance management mechanisms are handled with a holistic approach. Key performance indicators are included in our strategic plan. There are also other performance indicators determined by the departments in their strategic plans. Performance indicators are measured every 6 months and the results of the analyses are reported. The performance management system will be converted by the Department of Information Technologies and Security into an internet-based system from which data can be extracted. Work on this issue is ongoing. Improvement is planned for deviations in performance indicators.

In my next article, we will continue our series of articles with the third title under the title of Leadership, Quality and Governance. Our bulletin is full thanks to you.

I would like to thank our department head Asst. Prof. Özgül ÖZKOÇ for her support and leadership.


I would like to thank my teammate Eda Gülbakan, with whom I always enjoy and benefit from working together, and look forward to accomplishing more beautiful work together.



Improved Performance and Cost Algorithm for Scheduling IoT Tasks in Fog-Cloud Environment Using Gray Wolf Optimization Algorithm

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Abstract: Today, the IoT has become a vital part of our lives because it has entered into the precise details of human life, like smart homes, healthcare, eldercare, vehicles, augmented reality, and industrial robotics. Cloud computing and fog computing give us services to process IoT tasks, and we are seeing a growth in the number of IoT devices every day. This massive increase needs huge amounts of resources to process it, and these vast resources need a lot of power to work because the fog and cloud are based on the term pay-per-use. We make to improve the performance and cost (PC) algorithm to give priority to the high-profit cost and to reduce energy consumption and Makespan; in this paper, we propose the performance and cost–gray wolf optimization (PC-GWO) algorithm, which is the combination of the PCA and GWO algorithms. The results of the trial reveal that the PC-GWO algorithm reduces the average overall energy usage by 12.17%, 11.57%, and 7.19%, and reduces the Makespan by 16.72%, 16.38%, and 14.107%, with the best average resource utilization enhanced by 13.2%, 12.05%, and 10.9% compared with the gray wolf optimization (GWO) algorithm, performance and cost algorithm (PCA), and Particle Swarm Optimization (PSO) algorithm.


