FROM OUR EDITOR

Dear Stakeholders

We spent the month of March intensively, on the one hand, with the YOKAK Institution Internal Evaluation Report studies, which we prepared with your contribution, and the collection and reporting processes of the data uploaded to the YOK-YOKAK joint platform, and on the other hand, with the student-centered training, midterm exams and activities of our students. Our university continues to work in line with its strategic plan goals in a fast and exciting way. One of the events that made us most proud in March was the success of our students, who were entitled to be supported by TUBITAK. We would like to take this opportunity to congratulate both our students and their advisors.

Let's continue our informative article on YOKAK standards with Management Systems, the third sub-heading of the Leadership Governance and Quality section. Management Systems encompass Information Management Systems, Human Resources Management, Financial Management, and Process Management.

Information Management System: In line with the digitalization processes of our university, our Information Technologies and Security Department produces many projects. A data platform on sustainability has been created. In May, works for the establishment of a web-based data entry platform for our Department of Strategy and Quality Assurance is about to be completed. Thus, we will have an integrated information management system and more strong process management. We have an infrastructure to protect personal data and information confidentiality, and regular checks for privacy are going on.

Human Resources Management: We have defined rules and processes for human resources management at our university. These processes are transparent, accessible, and known by everyone in the organization. Education and merit are the primary criteria, and increasing competencies is the main goal. Various trainings are provided in line with achieving our goals.

We have surveys and opinion suggestion forms developed to determine and monitor employee (academic-administrative) satisfaction, complaints, and suggestions, and used actively. Suggestions and survey results are reviewed, and improvements are implemented when necessary. Most recently, a survey was conducted in March to obtain the opinions and suggestions of our academic and administrative staff. We will share the results with you when they are analyzed.

Financial Management: At the university, basic income and expense items are defined and monitored. Our processes are carried out transparently and by sharing with relevant institutions. Planning, utilization, and monitoring practices of financial resources are managed in line with the strategic plan of our institution. For this purpose, a field showing the relationship between the requests and the strategic plan was set up on the budget entry screen, and approvals were made accordingly.

Process Management: Processes and sub-processes (including distance education) for all activities are defined. Those responsible for the processes are specified and internalized by the whole institution. We have stakeholder participation in all our active processes, including our administrative processes. Nonconformities in our processes are evaluated through self-assessments, external assessments, stakeholder opinions and suggestions, etc. Revisions can be made when necessary.

In our next article, we will continue with the fourth topic of the Leadership Quality and Governance section, stakeholder engagement.

Quality and accreditation are elements that give a university a competitive advantage and strengthen the resilience of its institutional structure. It is clear that a university that is auditable, where ethical rules and quality approaches are internalized will stand out as a reputable institution. We are witnessing this directly in terms of the measurability of quality in education and training processes and institutional structure with the undergraduate program accreditations that have become widespread today.

In addition to education and training and institutional structure, this issue is also important in research. Data collection and analysis in accordance with standards and objective evaluation of the results are among the basic elements. In institutions where quality assurance and culture are established, we see that academic reputation is strong and more valuable contributions are made to both science and society. For this reason, quality assurance should also be prioritized in research and development processes at universities.

As Altınbaş University, we participated in a major event emphasizing the importance of quality assurance and accreditation, the 2024 YOKAK International Quality Assurance and Accreditation Conference on 25-26 April 2024. The conference, which took place at Ankara Hacı Bayram Veli University, was attended by the President of YOK, the president of YOKAK, representatives at the level of rectors, vice rectors and deans of universities, and representatives of international accreditation and quality organizations. During the conference, current scientific approaches and good practice examples on accreditation, quality assurance, accurate collection and evaluation of data in academia were discussed. In his speech, YOKAK President stated that 35% of our universities have YOKAK institutional accreditation and that they want this number to increase. As Altınbaş University, we were also happy to receive our institutional accreditation certificate directly from the presidents of YOK and YOKAK.

We would like to thank our Board of Trustees, Rectorate, academic units, administrative units and our students who contributed.
