FROM OUR EDITOR

Dear Stakeholders,

In this month's article, we will talk about **Stakeholder Engagement** under the title of **Leadership Governance and Quality**. According to YÖKAK standards, the institution should establish and manage the necessary systems to receive, respond to and use feedback from internal and external stakeholders to ensure their participation in strategic decisions and processes. In this context, a Stakeholder Management Procedure has been established and published at our university. In addition, the stakeholders of our university have been identified and prioritised, and each unit has added its own stakeholders to this list. In order to receive effective feedback from our stakeholders, we continue to strengthen our relations with them. For this purpose, we invite our stakeholders to the events we organise and attend the events they invite us to.

We provide feedback from both internal and external stakeholders through meetings, stakeholder-specific surveys and the opinion and suggestion platform we have created on our quality website. We improve our processes in line with the feedback we receive. In this context, we especially ask the academic and administrative staff team of our university to record these improvements and share copies with the Department of Strategy Development and Quality Assurance.

Under the heading of Stakeholder Engagement, we attach importance to our students' feedback on courses, instructors, diploma programmes, services and general satisfaction level, etc. Every year, we receive feedback from our students about the processes of our university and ensure that they are discussed in the relevant commissions.

Student Feedback: The opinions of our students, one of our internal stakeholders, are received systematically and in various ways. The opinions are analysed and shared with the public in a transparent manner. Various improvements are made by evaluating the results of the analyses. Our students can also submit their complaints to the student ombudsman department. Complaints are analysed through the Ombudsman's Office and improvements or information made as a result of necessary investigations are recorded.

Another sub-heading of Stakeholder Engagement is Alumni Relations Management.
