# FROM OUR EDITOR

Dear Stakeholders

In July, on the one hand, we graduated our students and enabled them to step into a new life with solid foundations, on the other hand, we met with prospective students and their families and helped them choose a department. We would like to thank the prospective students who visited our campuses and wish success to all prospective students.

We started the Education and Training section of YÖKAK standards last month and talked about the procedure we are preparing for the section titled Programme Design, Evaluation and Updating. The procedure was finalised in July and it was planned to be presented to stakeholders in August. The final version will be shared after stakeholder opinions. Article B2 of the standard is related to the **execution of programmes** and consists of four sub-

**B.2.1. Teaching Methods and Techniques;** In our university, Student-Centred education, including Distance Education, is essential and there are approaches that prioritise learning and these approaches are also stated in the course information packages as an improvement for 2024. Student Centred Education practices are monitored with student feedback. For this purpose, a Student Evaluation Survey is conducted every semester. The results of the survey are analysed in general and faculty member-oriented terms, and the general report is shared with the entire academic staff and all faculty member-based results are shared with the rectorate. The relevant academic unit managers are informed about the results of the lecturers working in their units so that they can implement improvements.

B.2.2. Measurement and Evaluation: Measurement and evaluation at our university is provided by multiple examination opportunities and some process-oriented (formative) methods such as homework, projects, portfolios. There are mechanisms for exam administration and security (formal/online exams, exams for disadvantaged groups). Students who take the exam sign the exam report, exams are conducted in the presence of a proctor, and disadvantaged individuals in need of support are provided with individual solutions in line with their needs. Feedback on assessment and evaluation is used to improve these systems. The matrix for assessment and evaluation practices to ensure programme competence is included in the Student-Centred Education and Training Report and these reports are evaluated at the end of the term.

**B.2.3.** Student Admission, Recognition and Crediting of Prior Learning: In addition to central placement, Altınbaş University Vertical Transfer Directive, Altınbaş University Undergraduate Application Registration Directive for Students from Abroad, Altınbaş University Undergraduate Transfer Directive between Associate and Undergraduate Programmes and Altınbaş University Full Recognition Directive for Student Exchange Programmes have been

prepared. Applications are managed in accordance with these directives. **B.2.4. Certification of Qualifications and Diploma:** Practices such as approval of qualifications,

graduation conditions, graduation decision processes are determined for each programme and
